Who can apply

Digital artists 18+ of any nationality are invited to apply. Where applications are judged to be of similar quality, *Not Quite Write* will favour Australian applicants.

This is a **paid** opportunity.

We will supply our brief in advance of each round of the competition, with a 2 week turnaround for final artwork delivery. As the images will be based on our competition prompts, a strict non-disclosure policy applies until the corresponding prompts are released.

All images must be framed to accommodate portrait, landscape and square cropping, and supplied in high resolution for use in digital and print applications. Upon acceptance, final artwork will become the exclusive property of *Not Quite Write*, however you may use the image in your own portfolio and personal promotion.

What you will receive

- The title of *2027 Not Quite Write Artist in Residence*.
- Payment of **AU\$350 per image** via bank transfer (Australia) or PayPal (international) following approval and acceptance of each final image.
- Artistic credit and social media tagging (Instagram, Facebook and Bluesky).
